Subject: Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) – Customer Advisory

Dear Seacat customer,

Due to the ongoing geopolitical instability in the Middle East, global oil prices have risen sharply, leading to a significant increase in bunker fuel costs.

As our daily operating costs have risen sharply over the past two weeks, Seacat n.v. will implement an Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS), in order to maintain our weekly service between Costa Rica and Florida and vice versa. The Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) will be as follows:

Maritime transport

- Reefer Units : USD 350 per unit
- Dry Units : USD 250 per unit

US Land based transport

- Reefer Units : USD 60 per unit
- Dry Units : USD 30 per unit

This Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) will apply to all Seacat sailings effective 25th March 2026, both north- and southbound, and will remain in place until further notice, subject to periodic review in accordance with international fuel market developments.

Current market conditions are highly volatile, and we sincerely appreciate your continued support and understanding as we remain committed to providing our customers with reliable and high-quality service.
